Mohandas Gandhi lived in India. He helped people learn how to become more powerful without fighting.

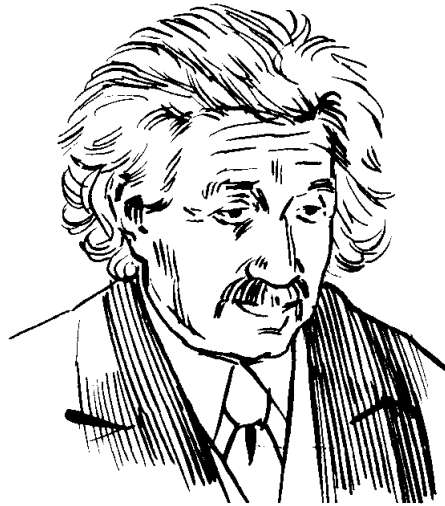
