NARRATOR 1:

NARRATOR 2:

NARRATOR 1:

NARRATOR 2:

Surprised committee members look at one another. They nod yes.

NARRATOR 1:

The King of Hearts opens the door. A very short man with a large green thumb on his right hand walks in. He smiles when the King shakes his hand and introduces him to the group.

LITTLE GERRY GREEN THUMB: (sitting down)

Thank you for taking the time to meet with me.

MUFFIN MAN:

Mr. Green Thumb, please tell us why you want to join our land.

LITTLE GERRY GREEN THUMB:

I like the diversity of characters in your kingdom.

LITTLE NANCY ETTICOAT: (puzzled)

Our diversity? Please explain.

LITTLE GERRY GREEN THUMB:

Sure. The members of your kingdom are of many backgrounds, abilities, and ages. Each character is unique.

OLD MOTHER GOOSE:

Mr. Green Thumb, have people made fun of you in the past?

NARRATOR 1:

NARRATOR 1:

NARRATOR 2:

KING OF HEARTS:

Great! I'll give him the good news.

NARRATOR 1:

With Little Gerry's help, this is the best crop of peppers I've had in years! They'll make great pickled peppers.

NARRATOR 2:
