Follow the directions to make the accordion book.

Materials

- one 6" x 18" (15 cm x 46 cm) strip of colored construction paper
- one 6" x 18" (15 cm x 46 cm) strip of white construction paper
- glue
- black marker
- crayons

Directions

- 1. Glue together the long sides of the construction paper strips and allow the glue to dry.
- 2. Fold the project accordion-style into four equal sections. In each section, the top white portion is for the illustration and the colored section below it is for the writing.
- 3. Write the title of the book on the front of the accordion book and draw an illustration above it.
- 4. Open the book and, on each of the next three pages, write one of your summary sentences and a picture to go with it.
