Make a Peace Windsock

Design and create a windsock to symbolize your feelings about peace. When you have completed it, hang your windsock in the classroom or at home.

Materials:

• red and white crepe paper streamers

• blue construction paper, 9 x 18 inches (23 x 46 cm)

• glue, stapler, scissors, tape

white chalk or silver glitter

yarn or string

Directions:

1. Think about what pictures symbolize peace for you. Use white chalk or glue and glitter to make these pictures on the blue paper.

2. Form the blue construction paper into a cylinder.

3. Glue the shorter side closed. Staple it to make sure it doesn't come undone.

4. Attach red and white streamers to one end with glue.

5. Cut three 12-inch (30.5 cm) lengths of string. Tape them to the top of the blue cylinder, about six inches (15 cm) apart.

6. Knot the three strings together to make a hanger.
