

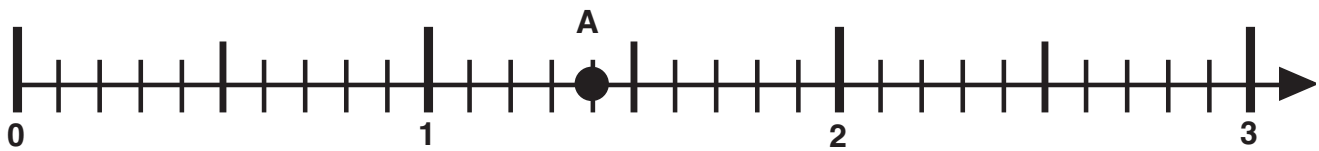
## 9—Leafy Lengths

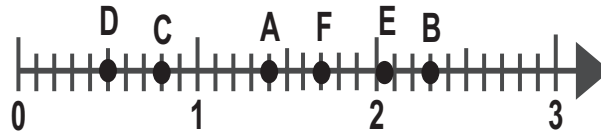
