
Animal Homes

Beavers build their homes. Their homes are called lodges. Beavers use sticks, logs, rocks and mud to build the lodge. Their homes are built in streams, lakes and ponds. The inside of a beaver lodge is the shape of a cave and is dry. Beavers swim under the water to get in to their homes.
