  2. You must respect the environment's role in the creation and sustainability of life.
  3. You should be able to recognize bad environmental practices and avoid them.
  4. Good stewardship requires you to initiate projects to help rebuild the environment when damage has been done.
  5. As a good steward, you must develop a healthy attitude toward money. Don't treasure money to the extent you will harm the environment to get money.
  6. Understand that being a good steward is a way of life.
