Hockey Word Problems

Solve the word problems about time.

1.	Mike and Eric were playing in a hockey game. Their team needed to score one goal to win the game. There was one minute and 45 seconds left to play in the game. If it took Mike and Eric 37 seconds to skate down the rink and score, how much time was left?
2.	Tanya was watching a hockey game. She knows that each period is 20 minutes long. Right now, they have been playing for 10 minutes and 30 seconds. How much time is left in the period?
3.	Mary is sitting on the bench waiting for her turn to play. The clock shows that there are 5 minutes and 22 seconds left. It takes Mary 18 seconds to get out on the ice. If she gets off the bench right now (with 5 minutes and 22 seconds left), how much time will be left by the time she gets on the ice?
4.	Sophia is practicing hockey with her team. Practice started at 6:15. Sophia knows that practice is one hour and 10 minutes long. What time will practice end?
5.	Landon loves to watch his favorite hockey team when they are on TV. He starts watching the second period at 7:32. The periods are 20 minutes long. What time will the second period be over (pretend there is no reason for the clock to stop during this period)?
6.	Kenny is practicing shooting hockey goals with two of his friends. They each get to shoot for 3 minutes. If they start practicing at 4:20 and they each get three turns, what time will they finish practicing shooting goals?
