

Comparing Numbers

Compare the numbers in each word problem.

1. Two groups of geese are migrating. One group has 22 birds in it. One group has 31 birds in it. Compare the numbers and fill in the correct symbol ($<$, $>$, $=$).

$$22 \quad \square \quad 31$$

2. Two groups of elk are migrating. One group has 19 elk in it and one group has 15 elk in it. Compare the numbers and fill in the correct symbol ($<$, $>$, $=$).

$$19 \quad \square \quad 15$$

3. Two groups of whales are migrating. One group has 46 whales in it. The other group has 46 whales in it. Compare the numbers and fill in the correct symbol ($<$, $>$, $=$).

$$46 \quad \square \quad 46$$

4. Two groups of bison are migrating. One group has 51 bison in it and the other group has 15 bison in it. Compare the numbers and fill in the correct symbol ($<$, $>$, $=$).

$$51 \quad \square \quad 15$$
