

# Animal Migration

Read about why animals migrate and then answer the questions.

Many mammals, birds, fishes, insects, and other animals move from one place to another at certain times of the year. This is called migration.

Animals migrate for different reasons. Many migrate to have babies or to find food. Some animals migrate to places where they can hibernate, or rest for the winter. Others migrate because the weather is too hot, too cold, too wet, or too dry during certain times of the year.

Most animals migrate across water, land, or air. Migrations can take place either during the day or at night.
