Bonus Activity \#1: Create a color key in the bottom right corner of the map, where a specific color will show that a certain number of presidents were born in a particular state. (Example: Blue =0-2 presidents, Red =3-4 presidents, and so on.) Color each state the appropriate color.

Bonus Activity \#2: On a separate sheet of paper, make a bar graph showing the number of presidents born in each of the states. On the vertical side of the graph, list numbers from zero (at the bottom) to as high as needed (at the top). On the horizontal side of the graph, list the postal abbreviations of the states, beginning (on the left) with the state where the fewest presidents were born and ending (on the right) with the state where the most presidents were born. Color in a bar for each state to represent the number of presidents born in that state.
