Answer the following questions: 1. In which state were the most presidents born? 2. In which state were the fewest presidents born?



Bonus Activity #2: On a separate sheet of paper, make a bar graph showing the number of presidents born in each of the states. On the vertical side of the graph, list numbers from zero (at the bottom) to as high as needed (at the top). On the horizontal side of the graph, list the postal abbreviations of the states, beginning (on the left) with the state where the fewest presidents were born and ending (on the right) with the state where the number of presidents born in that state.
