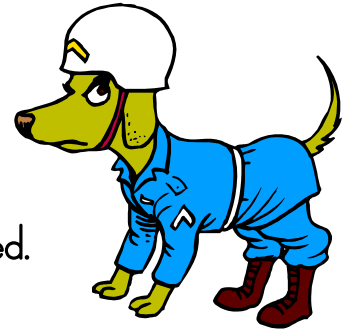


# Irregular Verbs



Irregular verbs are verbs that do not change from the present tense to the past tense in the regular way by ending with d or ed.

Examples: Sing = Sang      Break = Broke
