1. IL RT AGE CA

This flexible material is located between bones, on the tip of your nose, and top of your ear.

2. LO IS IG TT EP

This flops down over your windpipe to keep you from choking on food.

3. NS TE NDO

These attach your muscles to your bones.

4. TI NA RE

Light hits this and sends messages to your brain.

5. RY LA NX

This works with air from your lungs to let you talk and sing.

6. TIN RA KE

This hard protein is found in your hair.

7. IDE IS RM EP

This is the outermost layer of your skin.

8. RA APH GM DI

This muscle separates your lungs from your stomach and intestines.

9. BE CE UM RE LL

This controls your balance, coordination, and movement.

10 RIA CTE BA

These can help or hurt our body, depending on their type.
