

Plant Poster

Culminating Assessment: Plant Poster

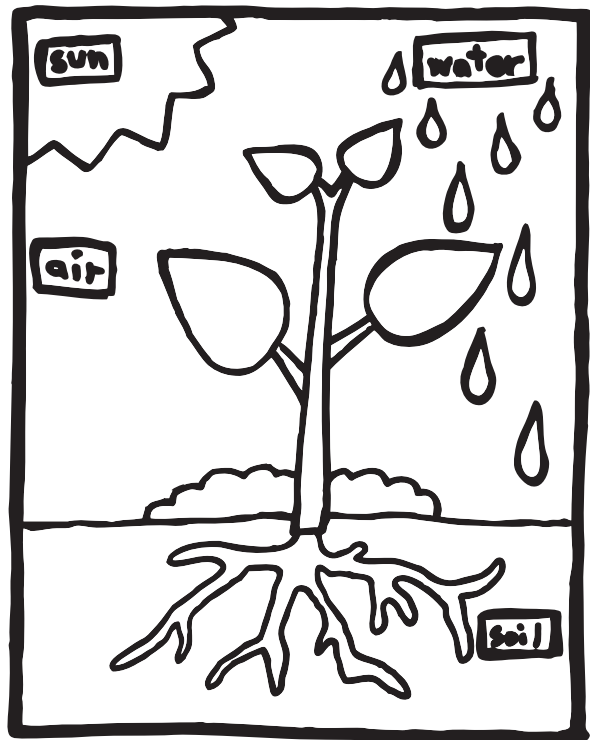
Objective: The students will show an understanding of what plants need to grow by creating a poster and labeling plant needs.

Materials (for each student)

- 12" x 18" sheet of white or light blue construction paper (background)
- 4.5" x 6" sheet of yellow or orange construction paper (sun)
- 4.5" x 12" sheet of brown construction paper (soil)
- 4.5" x 6" sheet of medium or dark blue construction paper (water)
- 4.5" x 9" sheet of green construction paper (stem and leaves)
- 4.5" x 6" sheet of light brown construction paper (roots)
- Plant Poster Labels (below)
- glue, scissors, crayons, pencils

Directions for Teacher

1. Photocopy the labels (below) for each child.
2. Distribute materials to each child.
3. Discuss the labels. Explain that the children will need to choose only those labels that show what a plant needs. (Explain that some labels will not be used.)
4. Have the students create a Plant Poster, showing the parts of a plant and what it needs.
5. Have the students cut out the correct labels (*air, soil, sunlight, water*) and glue each to the corresponding part of the Plant Poster.
6. Glue those labels on the proper spots on their posters.
