



## Verbs—Is/Are

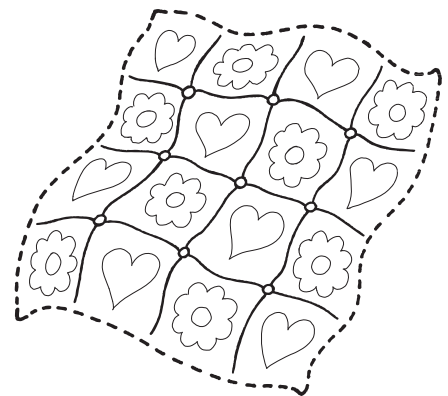
A **verb** is the action word in a sentence. A verb tells what the person, place, or thing does.

- Use *is* for singular nouns.  
Example: My brother is very smart.
- Use *are* for plural nouns.  
Example: My sisters are very smart, too.
