- 1. The United States suffered 407,000 military deaths in World War II, and Great Britain had 388,000. How many more Americans died than British?
- 2. The Soviet Union losses included 13,600,000 military deaths and 7,700,000 civilian deaths. How many casualties did they have altogether?
- 3. Of the 6 million civilian deaths in Poland, 2.9 million were Jews. How many of the civilian deaths were not Jews?
- 4. World War II cost the Soviet Union 21,300,000 lives. It cost the United States 407,000 lives. How many more Soviets were killed than Americans?
- 5. Germany's losses totaled 3,250,000 soldiers and 3,810,000 civilian lives. How many losses did Germany have altogether?
- 6. China suffered 1,324,000 military deaths and 10,000,000 civilian deaths. How many more civilians were killed than soldiers?
- 7. Russia fatalities were 21,300,000 lives. Germany lost 7,060,000 lives. What was the percentage of German losses compared to Russia's?
- 8. Poland lost 6,850,000 lives, and 6,000,000 of those were civilians. What percentage of Poland's losses were civilians?
- 9. Total World War II deaths were estimated at 52 million lives. Japan's losses numbered about 2 million. What percentage of the total deaths were Japanese?
- 10. What percentage of the 52 million deaths in World War II did Germany suffer if it had about 7 million deaths?
